NJHS 2012 INDUCTEES

Students inducted into Junior Honor Society must be in grades 6-8 have to meet a scholastic attainment of 3.4 (85% B) on a 4.0 scale. Those students are given the opportunity to fill out a form including information about themselves relating to character, service, leadership, and citizenship. A faculty council reviews their forms and discusses their candidacy. The faculty council votes on each candidate.

Those receiving a majority vote based on their information and the five pillars of scholarship, citizenship, character, leadership, and service are then invited to be inducted at a formal ceremony.

The Spirit of the Torch is the NJHS symbol. That person will introduce the ideals of NJHS (Character, Citizenship, Scholarship, Leadership, and Service) that completes our circle of light. One student will represent each of the ideals and tell about the color in the circle of light that they signify. After the qualifications for membership have been presented, the inductees will be escorted forward. They will pass the light to each other from our central flame and take the pledge of NJHS.

UNITED WAY FUNDRAISER

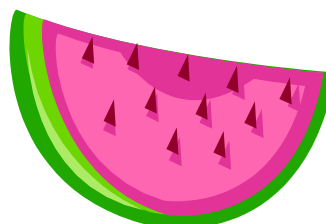
