LONEDELL R-14 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The amount awarded for Scholarships each year shall be determined by the Lonedell R-14 Scholarship Committee based on the availability of funds and the numbers and types of requests.

SCHOLARSHIP BY-LAWS

- A. Scholarships shall be awarded each year to individuals who are committed to continuing their education. <u>Scholarships may be awarded up to five times within eight years of graduating high school</u>.
- A. Applications shall be distributed in January to St. Clair High School, Grandview High School, Lonedell R-14 School, or go to our website: http://www.lonedell.org.
- B. Anyone graduating from the eighth grade at Lonedell R-14 School may obtain a scholarship application form.
- C. Applications submitted by April 3, 2017 shall be considered, and the scholarship(s) will be awarded during the eighth grade graduation ceremonies. Recipients of scholarships will be notified by the end of the first week of May.
- D. Scholarship payments shall be made to the individual to be used for college expenses or fulfilling educational needs and goals.
- E. If, for any reason- health, scholarship, personal, desire, or any other reason- the scholarship recipient withdraws or is dismissed from the school before the end of the scholarship period, the recipient agrees to repay the Lonedell R-14 School the total amount expended. At the discretion of the Lonedell Scholarship Committee, such repayment may be permitted in installments.
