# Out of This World—2017



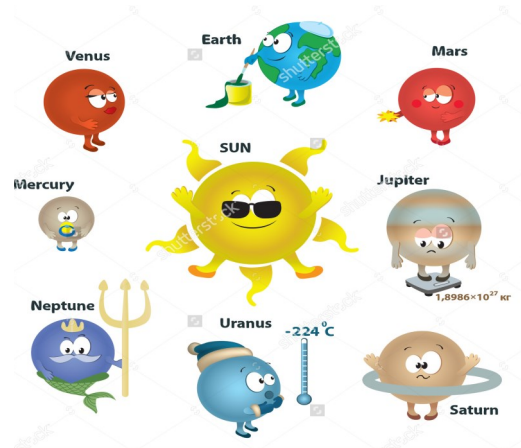
Each class will research a planet for a collective display throughout the weeks of summer school. They will learn about:
