CLASSROOM SUPPLIES

- 4-boxes of 24 count crayons
- 2-4oz. Elmer's wet glue
- 8 -glue sticks
- 1 pair metal Fiskars scissors
- 1- 4 pack of EXPO dry erase markers (NO Crayola brand, please)
- 2- 3-prong plastic folders (solid colors, please)
- 1 - 1 inch 3 ring binder **with a plastic sleeve in the front**
- 1 sturdy crayon/pencil **BAG** with zipper (no boxes please)
- 1-3 pack of baby wipes
- Girls bring 2 rolls of paper towels, quart size ziplock bags with zipper
- Boys bring 2 boxes of Kleenex, gallon size ziplock bags with zipper
- 1 package assorted colored construction paper
- 1 pair of headphones (no ear buds, please)
- 1 package of 25 page protectors

PERSONAL SUPPLIES

- 1 standard size backpack
- 1 full change of clothes (please put clothes in a large Ziploc bag)

Please do not put your child's name on the classroom supply items. Supplies will be handed out as needed. These items should last us the entire year, however from time to time we may need to ask for your help purchasing items as they are needed. **We ask that you not send trapper keepers/art boxes.** They are too large to fit in their mailboxes.

You **do** need to put your child's name on their backpack, crayon/pencil bag, and emergency clothes bag.

The following items we use frequently in our classroom and are purchased by teachers. If you would like to send any of these additional items in, we would greatly appreciate it, but is NOT required.

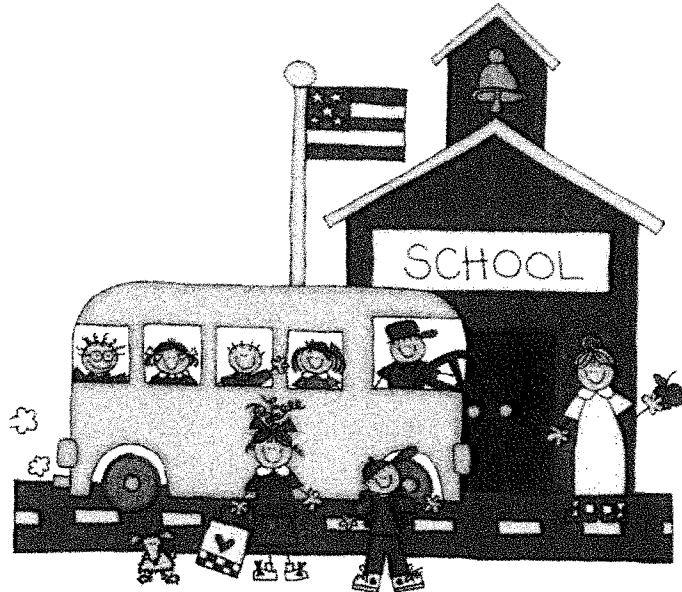
