

LONEDELL R-14 SCHOOL BOARD

ELECTIONS 2023 / 2024

The Lonedell R-14 School District encourages qualified persons interested in running for a position on the School Board to file to be a candidate in the April 2nd, 2024, election. Interested candidates must file in person at the central office located at 7466 Hwy. FF Lonedell, MO 63060. There are two positions available with three-year terms.

Filing will begin on December 5th, 2023 at 8:00 a.m. and will continue during the district's regular business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Filing will end on December 26th, 2023, at 5:00 p.m.

Filing will not occur on the following holidays and breaks when the school district's central office will be closed: December 20th leaving at 12:00 p.m., Closed: December 21st, 22nd, and 25th, 2023. On December 26th, the last day of filing, the office will be open from 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. The office may also be closed for inclement weather.

A candidate must be a citizen of the United States, at least 24 years of age, and a resident taxpayer of the district who has resided in Missouri for one (1) year preceding the election.

- VOLUNTEERS**
They volunteer their time and expertise and are not paid.
- Non-Partisan**
They are not elected as representatives of a political party. Their loyalty is to students and their success.
- Elected**
They are elected by voters in each school district.
- Local**
They live in the school district and pay taxes.
- TEAM PLAYERS**
They are required by law to work as a team to make decisions for all the students in their community.
