## Lonedell R-14 School District Re-Entry Plan for 2020-2021

In a time where our families have various needs, concerns and viewpoints regarding the safety and education of their child(ren), our district remains committed to serving your family and meeting your child(ren)s academic, physical and social/emotional needs.

Below you will find a brief outline of the attendance options for your child(ren) for the 2020-21 school year at Lonedell R-14. More detailed information will follow, including information on registering for remote learning options, if you desire.

## **On-Campus Option**



- Instruction will take place On-Campus. Students will attend school 5 days per week and will be taught by certified teachers of the Lonedell R-14 School District.
- Implementation of health and safety practices will be instituted that are advised by the CDC and local public health departments (self-screening, distancing when possible, staggered approach to recess, hand washing, sanitizing, etc)
- A tiered approach for safety measures regarding onsite instruction has been adopted that will react in a "step-down" fashion to any increased health concerns in our area. (See Tiered Safety Measures for Onsite Instruction Document)

## **ONLINE** INSTRUCTION

- This option of Remote Learning is available for K-8 families who have access to high speed, reliable internet service, capable of streaming video and supporting online meetings.
- \* Students will participate in newly designed e-learning at home.
- \* Students will be taught by certified educators of the Lonedell R-14 School District.
- \* Students in grades 3-8 will be utilizing Windows Computers (district issued).
- Students in grades K-2 will be utilizing Apple iPads (district issued).

Pre-K instruction will NOT be available in either Remote Learning Scenario, off-site options are for K-8 Students ONLY.

## DISTANCE

**Remote Learning Options (Off Campus)** 

- This option of Remote Learning is available for K-8 families who wish to remain off-campus, but who lack reliable, high speed internet, or internet that is not capable of streaming videos and supporting online meetings.
- \* Students will participate in newly designed elearning at home (same as the online option)
- \* Students will be taught by certified educators of the Lonedell R-14 School District.
- Students grades 3-8 will be utilizing Windows Computers (district issued), along with jump drives downloaded with instructional content and delivered by buses 2-3 times per week, to allow for teacher feedback.
- Students grades K-2 will utilize Apple iPads (district issued). Instructional content will be downloaded to the device and delivered to students 2-3 times per week to allow for feedback.
