Lonedell R-14 Distanced Learning Plan (AMI-X) for Families



In the event we need to close for a period of time or if an individual student has to be quarantined, below are our classroom's plans for keeping learning going! On days we are implementing remote learning, your attendance is counted by participation in and completion of the assignments at home.



The Plan...

When and how can the student and the parent/guardian connect with the teacher?

• The teachers will be available from 8am to 3pm on the first day of our closure or individual student quarantine to answer any questions and help you get started. Parents/Guardians/Family members can contact the teacher through the SEESAW parent and family application, email, or by phone. Students can contact their teacher through CLEVER. How to instructions for these communication methods can be found below.

How will I access learning materials?

- If your child is connecting online, information will be sent via SEESAW by 9am on the first day and then 8am each day after the building is closed or if your child is quarantined. The work assigned each day will need to be completed before the next day.
- If you are doing work on your own at home (not online), this work will be sent home the first day through the bus service. We will communicate the time through the district messaging system (text, phone call, and email). After the first delivery, we will communicate the specific days and times of drop off and pick up of work and technology to view videos. This exchange will occur 2-3 times a week. It is vital that you stay engaged by reviewing all texts, phone calls, and emails from the district.

How will my child get the technology device (iPad or computer)?

- If your child is in grades K-5, the district will arrange a time to come pick up your technology device needed to complete student work.
- If your child is in grades 6-8, students who have paid insurance should already have the computer that they will use to complete work. Students who have not paid insurance and do not bring computers home will be included in the device pick up event.

Is there a handbook for the technology device and does the district offer insurance?

• If your child is quarantined or if the school is closed, we have a One2One Handbook that discusses responsibilities with school provided technology for both parents/guardians and students. We also offer insurance that you can purchase at that time (unless your child has already purchased the insurance and signed the handbook form).
